Mrs Lewis informed parents of the feedback received from the recent survey regarding wraparound care, and enrichment clubs. It was seen as very successful with 81% of children represented in the responses, showing that parents are very supportive of the schools' efforts to meet their needs.

More enrichment clubs will be offered and these will be charged for.

Bookings must be made for a whole term with a commitment not to chop and change

Efforts will be made not to cancel enrichment clubs but to cover them with other staff so as not to create un-necessary inconvenience for parents

Booking forms will be sent out for clubs, wraparound care and minibus – confirmation will be sent home

School has managed to recruit more staff for Munch Bunch to enable extended provision until 6.00pm and to return to higher capacity.

- Realised having Church Service and Parents Forum on the same day as Sports Day may have contributed to fewer parents being able to attend both events. Having Parent's Forums at different venues and different times allows more parents to attend.
